Remote Learning Clarifications

School is in session 5 days a week (unless there is a scheduled day off), regardless if learning is scheduled to occur in person, through Zoom classes, or through activities posted on schoology.

Students will be counted “present” for school by doing the following:

- attending classes in school (on their scheduled in-person days)
- attending classes on Zoom (on their scheduled Zoom days)
- completing daily assignments (on their independent days)

Just like the normal school day, students attending school remotely are expected to be on time and present. If a student needs to miss a remote session of school, the parent should contact the teacher ahead of time and also send a note to the office for documentation. The student is still expected to complete all school work.

If a student misses a scheduled Zoom class (without prior communication), the teacher will send an email/Remind to the parent. After 3 missed classes, the teacher will notify the Principal to set up a meeting with the family. Similarly, if students are showing a pattern of not submitting work on their remote or independent days, the teacher will contact the parent. If this continues, the teacher will notify the Principal to set up a meeting with the family.

All policies and procedures from our normal attendance policy (see student handbook) will still be followed during remote and hybrid learning.
